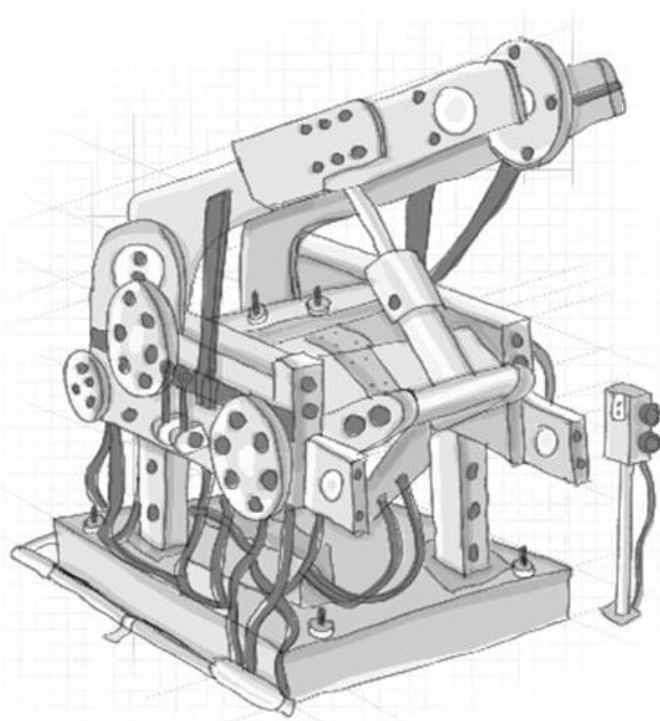

Transformation to a platform driven company

Engineering to order - *project* driven



- > Starting point is the **copy of an old reference solution**
- > Missing defined interfaces lead to **high engineering effort**
- > **High uncertainty in project scope** at contract signing



Configure to order - *platform* driven



- > New offers are **configured** using ready-to-use **building blocks**
- > **Engineering** focuses on **faster innovation**, rather than reinventing existing solutions
- > Modular portfolio **reduces project complexity** and improves **scalability**
- > **Shorter lead-times** improve competitiveness
- > More stable demand **reduces cost** along the value chain, **improves quality** and enables **services business**

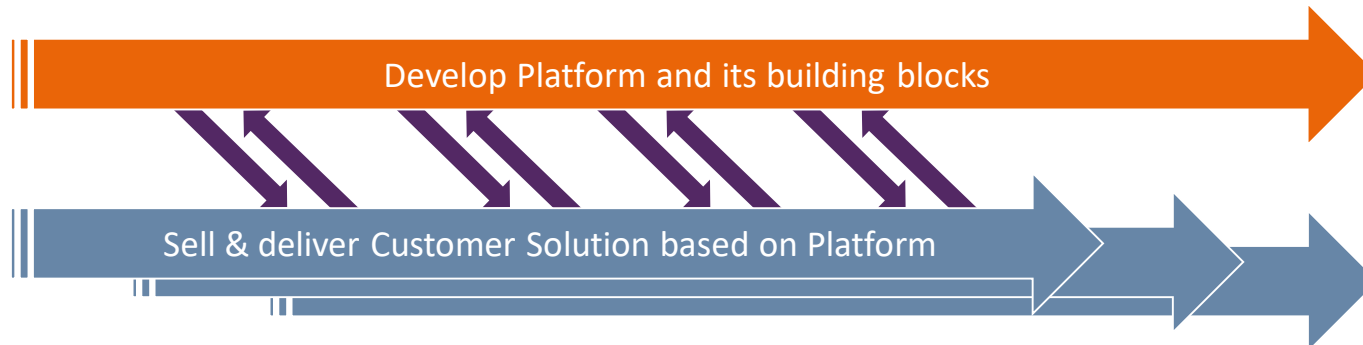

*How to assure that the solutions offered to our customers remain compliant to the **platform** AND to the **customer requirements**?*

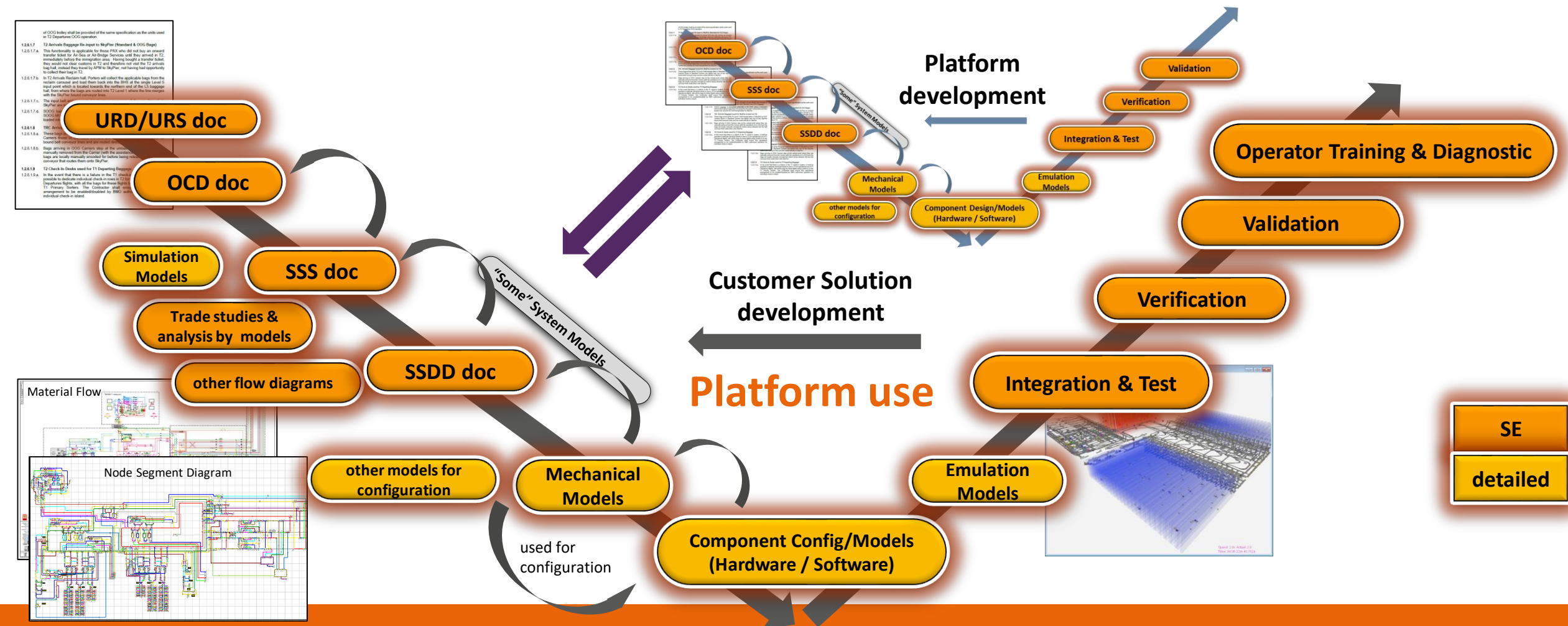

Document based, natural language, informal drawings & models, requirement traceability

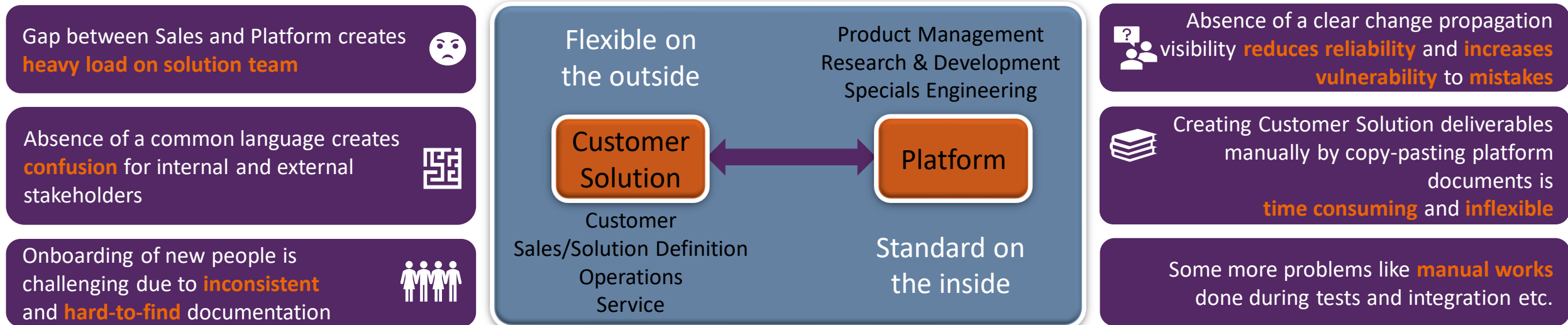


The WHY factor of MBSE in Vanderlande

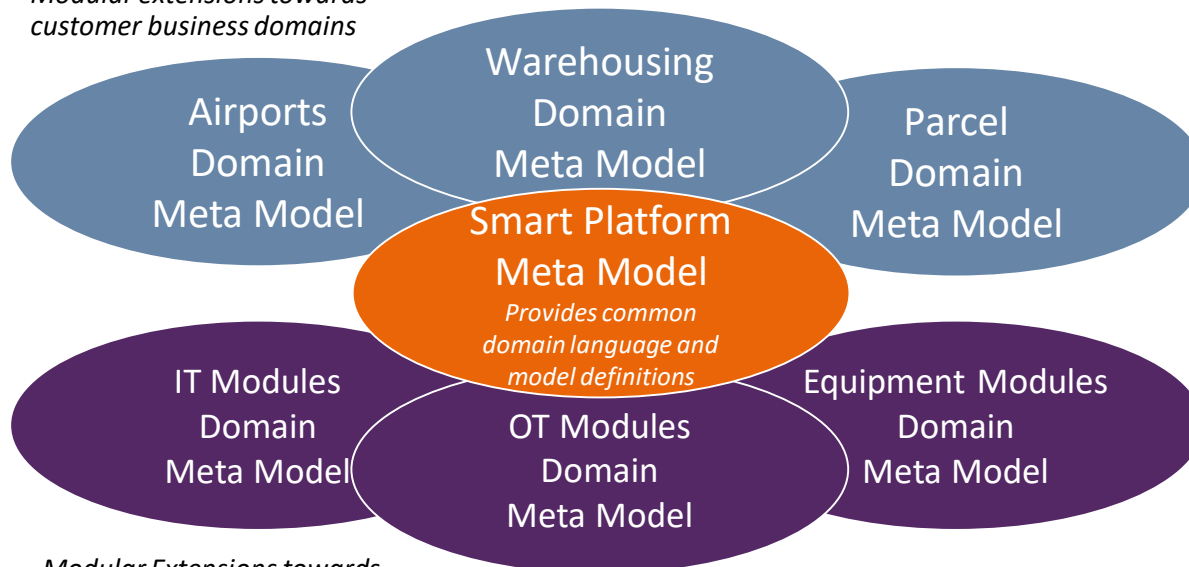

Modular models with common core to provide consistency *and* ownership

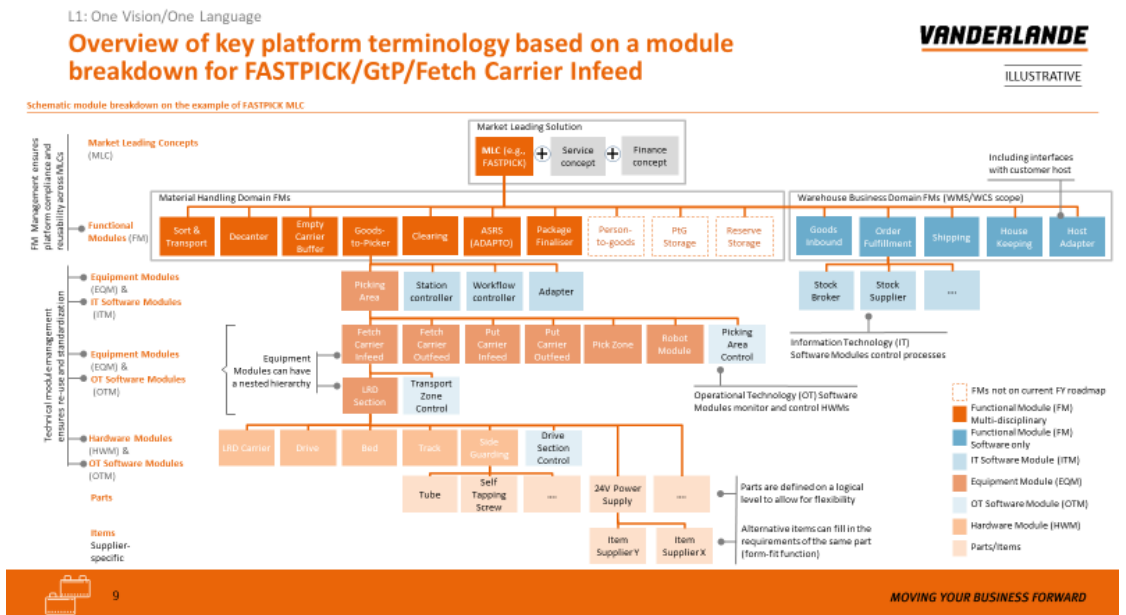
Keep models and their meta models *modular* to encourage ownership and acceptance (Conway's law also applies here)

Smart platform metamodel serves as common core and acts as the glue to provide consistency

MBSE for a Customer Solution
Modelling a system with user needs/requirements, its configuration, its integrated behaviour & structure and additional emergent behaviour

- > Fast and easy configuration, validation, supply, deployment and updates of **Customer Solutions** based on the platform building blocks
MBSE to hide complexity



MBSE for a Platform
Modelling a configurable, modular and reusable asset repository with enablers and configuration rules

- > Definition, analysis, development and rigorous test and integration of the **Platform building blocks** and their configuration options
MBSE to manage complexity
